Dear Mr. Stamper:

On November 17, 2004, PacifiCorp filed Revised Tariff Sheets to its First Revised FERC Rate Schedule No. 297, a Restated Transmission Service and Operating Agreement (RTSOA) between PacifiCorp and the Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems (UAMPS). The Revised Tariff Sheets provide updated Points of Delivery to which PacifiCorp provides transmission service for UAMPS under the RTSOA, and updated Points of Receipt for UAMPS resources wheeled under the RTSOA. Waiver of the notice requirements of section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted and the Revised Tariff Sheets are accepted for filing and made effective December 1, 2004, as requested.

This filing was noticed on November 23, 2004, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before December 8, 2004. No protests or adverse comments were received. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

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This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
