On November 30, 2004 and December 6, 2004 and as amended on January 24, 2005, you filed on behalf of PacifiCorp, Notices of Cancellation for various agreements.¹ Waiver of the notice requirements under Section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations is granted and PacifiCorp's submittals are conditional accepted for filing as discussed below with an effective date of December 31, 2004, as requested.

These filings were noticed on January 28, 2005 with comments due on February 14, 2005. No protests or adverse comments were received. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the PacifiCorp.
