MOTION FOR 30-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rules 212 and 2008 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212 & 385.2008 (2004), PacifiCorp hereby respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time to file an Amended and Restated Transmission Agreement between PacifiCorp and Tri-State generation and Transmission Association, Inc. (“Tri-State”)¹ in compliance with the requirements of Order No. 614² and in accordance with the Commission’s March 1, 2005 Letter Order in the above-referenced proceeding.³

I. BACKGROUND

On January 7, 2005, PacifiCorp submitted for filing Supplement No. 6 to its existing Transmission Agreement with Tri-State. Supplement No. 6 provides for PacifiCorp’s construction, paid for by Tri-State, of an additional point of delivery and associated equipment. PacifiCorp also submitted the original Agreement as well as Supplement Nos. 1 through 5, as required by Order 614. In its Letter Order, the Commission accepted for filing PacifiCorp’s Supplement No. 6 and instructed PacifiCorp

to: (1) refund the time value of the revenues actually collected for the period the rate was charged without Commission approval; and (2) submit a complete and up-to-date Rate Schedule No. 123, with all superseded language removed. The Commission instructed PacifiCorp to file this revised Transmission Agreement and a Refund Report within thirty (30) days of its Letter Order.

II. MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a short extension of time to comply with the requirements of the Letter Order. PacifiCorp has been working diligently with Tri-State to enter into a single Amended and Restated Transmission Agreement that incorporates all supplements and amendments. However, PacifiCorp does not expect to be able to execute that new agreement until June 2005. Therefore, PacifiCorp respectfully requests a limited extension of time of 30 calendar days to comply with the Commission's requirement to file a single Transmission Agreement with all superseded language removed in this docket.

PacifiCorp is not requesting an extension of time to file its Refund Report. PacifiCorp is filing its Refund Report concurrently with this Motion.
