**MOTION OF PACIFICORP FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to Rules 212 and 2008 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212 & 385.2008 (2004), PacifiCorp hereby respectfully requests an additional 120-day extension of time to submit its compliance filing in accordance with the Commission’s March 15, 2005 letter order in the above-referenced proceeding.<sup>1</sup>

On April 15, 2005, PacifiCorp filed an initial extension of time requesting an additional 30 days to comply with the Letter Order. On May 3, 2005, the Commission granted PacifiCorp’s request for an extension of time.<sup>2</sup> On May 4, 2005, PacifiCorp filed a second extension of time requesting an additional 60 days to comply with the Letter Order. On May 5, 2005, the Commission granted PacifiCorp’s request for an extension of time.<sup>3</sup> As discussed in more detail below, while PacifiCorp and its counter-party to the agreement, Bonneville Power Administration (“Bonneville”), have worked diligently to comply with the Letter Order and the requests for extension of time, Bonneville has now asked PacifiCorp for additional time to review the amended agreement. As a result,

PacifiCorp now respectfully requests an additional 120 days to comply with the Letter Order.

## **I. BACKGROUND**

On February 2, 2005, PacifiCorp submitted for filing an amendment to its existing AC Intertie Agreement (“Agreement”) with Bonneville.<sup>4</sup> As the Commission stated in the Letter Order, the amended Agreement provides for Bonneville’s use of PacifiCorp’s 500/230 kV transformer at the Malin Substation at a use-of-facilities charge. PacifiCorp also submitted the original Agreement, as well as Amendment Nos. 1 and 2, as required by the Commission’s Order No. 614.<sup>5</sup>

In its March 15, 2005 Letter Order, the Commission accepted for filing PacifiCorp's filing. The Commission also stated, however, that the amended Agreement did not comply with the requirements of Order No. 614 and, therefore, instructed PacifiCorp to submit within 30 days a complete and up-to-date Rate Schedule No. 368 with all superseded language removed.

## **II. MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission grant it an additional 120 day extension of time to comply with the requirements of the Letter Order. Since the issuance of the Letter Order, PacifiCorp has worked diligently with Bonneville to enter into an Amended and Restated AC Intertie Agreement. However, it now appears that the timetable to complete the Amended and Restated AC Intertie Agreement will be unavoidably delayed as Bonneville has asked PacifiCorp for more time to review the

Amended and Restated AC Intertie Agreement. As a result, PacifiCorp will be unable to file the updated Rate Schedule No. 368 in time to comply with the Letter Order and its requests for extensions of time.

Accordingly, PacifiCorp respectfully requests an additional time extension of 120 days to allow for the execution of an Amended and Restated AC Intertie Agreement with Bonneville and subsequent filing with the Commission of an updated Rate Schedule No. 368 in accordance with the requirements of Order No. 614.
