The sum of the Basic, Demand, Energy, and Reactive Power Charges. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedule 94.

Monthly Billing *(continued)*

Minimum Charge

The Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

Reactive Power Charge

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kVar in excess of 40% of the measured kW demand for the same month will be billed, at 60¢ per kVar of such excess reactive demand.

Demand

The kW as shown by or computed from the readings of Company's Demand meter for the 15-minute period of Customer's greatest use during the month, determined to the nearest whole kW.

Term of Contract

Company may require Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of one year.

Continuing Service

Except as specifically provided otherwise, this Schedule is based on continuing service at each service location. Disconnect and reconnect transactions are subject to the provisions set forth in Rule 3, Section VI of this tariff.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities.
