Monthly Billing

The Monthly Billing shall be the sum of the Basic, Demand and Energy Charges. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedule 94.

Basic Charge

Single-Phase	\$17.78 per month
Three-Phase	\$22.18 per month

Demand Charge

\$5.56	per kW for all kW of Monthly Billing Demand used during the On-season.

Monthly Billing Demand

The measured kW shown by or computed from the readings of Company's demand meter, or by appropriate test, for the 15-minute period of Customer's greatest use during the billing month. For billing months where there is metered energy usage the demand for motors of 10 HP or less may, subject to confirmation by test, be determined from the name plate HP rating and the following table:

5 HP or less	5 kW
Over 5 through 7.5 HP	7 kW
Over 7.5 through 10 HP	9 kW

Connection and Disconnection Charges

Company will connect and disconnect service at the beginning and end of Customer's pumping operation each year without charge. Customer shall give Company at least two weeks advance notice in writing of the date disconnection of service is desired. The actual expense incurred for additional connection and disconnection shall be paid by Customer. Customer shall give Company at least two weeks advance notice in writing of the date an additional connection and/or an additional disconnection of service is desired.

Term of Contract

Company may require Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of five years.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities.
