1. Company will replace individually burned out or broken lamps as soon as practicable after notification by the Customer.
2. Street lighting service under other conditions and for street lights of sizes and types not specified herein will be supplied under special contract.
3. Company may require Customer participation in the cost of installing circuit to render street lighting service when the length of such circuit from a source of suitable voltage on Company's system to the point of connection with the proposed street light or street lighting system is in excess of 300 feet.
4. Company may not be required to furnish service hereunder to other than Municipal Customers.

Special Conditions *(continued)*

5. The Customer may request temporary suspension of power for lighting by written request. During such periods, the monthly charge will be reduced by Company's estimated average monthly relamping and energy costs for the luminaire. Company will not be required to reestablish such service under this Schedule if service has been permanently discontinued by the Customer.

Term of Contract

1. For Company-owned systems the Company may require the Customer to sign written contract with a minimum term of:
One year for overhead service to street lights on wood poles
Five years for overhead service to street lights on metal poles
Ten years for underground service.
2. For Customer-owned systems, the Company may require the Customer to sign written contract with a minimum term of one year.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities.
