Applicable

To Customers desiring seasonal service for irrigation and soil drainage pumping installations. The Irrigation Season is from April 1 to September 30, and Post-Season service is available from October 1 to March 31.

Monthly Billing

The Monthly Billing shall be the sum of the Basic, Demand, Energy and Reactive Power Charges. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedule 94.

Basic Charge

Single Phase	\$15.00 per month
Three Phase	\$18.00 per month

Demand Charge

\$14.26 per kW for all kW of Billing Demand used during the irrigation season.

Energy Charge

0.574¢ per kWh for all kWh

Minimum Charge

The Basic Charge.

Reactive Power Charge

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kVar in excess of 40% of the measured kW demand for the same month will be billed at 60¢ per kVar of such excess reactive demand.

Prorating of Bills

Bills for service under this Schedule will be prorated for only the beginning and final service months of each calendar year.

Connection and Disconnection Charges

Company will connect and disconnect service at the beginning and end of Customer's pumping operation each year without charge. Customer shall give Company at least two weeks advance notice in writing of the date disconnection of service is desired. The actual expense incurred for additional connection and disconnection shall be paid by Customer. Customer shall give Company at least two weeks advance notice in writing of the date an additional connection and/or an additional disconnection of service is desired.

Demand

The kW as shown by or computed from the readings of the Company's Demand meter for the 15-minute period of Customer's greatest use during the month, determined to the nearest kW.

Term of Contract

Company may require Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of one year.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by regulatory authorities.
