Henefer outdoor pavilion effort gets a lift from the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation

HENEFER, Utah — The Rocky Mountain Power Foundation has awarded a \$4,000 grant to the town of Henefer to support the construction of a new outdoor pavilion and stage in the local park.

“Without the help provided by the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation, completing this project would have been extremely difficult,” said Henefer Mayor Randy Ovard. The new facility is scheduled for completion this spring.

Henefer, located in north Summit County, is known for its Fourth of July celebration, which draws crowds from around the county. Its new performance facility will provide local entertainers a place to perform and will attract talent from outside the area.

“The pavilion will be a terrific asset in a small town that prides itself on providing important cultural activities for the area,” said Chad Ambrose, Rocky Mountain Power customer and community manager. “It’s great that we can pitch in and help them build an enduring place for holding celebrations and community gatherings.”
