

**More than 1,000 residents of Fremont County will benefit from
grant to Lander Community Concerts Association**

LANDER, Wyo. – The Rocky Mountain Power Foundation has awarded a \$1,500 grant to the Lander Community Concerts Association (LCCA) to help support the Association’s hosting of the Repertory Dance Theatre on Jan. 19, 2011.
