2012 Equipment Exchange Application/Agreement

Thank you for choosing to improve the energy efficiency of your irrigation system by replacing worn irrigation parts with more efficient equipment. You can receive certain new equipment at no charge, by following these steps:

- Bring your used irrigation nozzles, gaskets, and drains to a Participating Dealer.
- Work with the dealer to select appropriate energy efficient replacement equipment.
- Complete this equipment exchange application and mail it to the Irrigation Energy Savers Program Administrator at the address shown on page 2.

Important: Your dealer will provide these parts to you free of charge, and if the application is in order, will be reimbursed through the Program Administrator and Rocky Mountain Power. Check rockymountainpower.net/ies or with your participating dealer to determine incentive eligibility. Submission of this application does not guarantee an incentive payment.

Eligibility Requirements

To participate in the Irrigation Energy Savers Program you must be a Rocky Mountain Power Schedule 10 customer who currently uses electricity for agricultural irrigation and who receives electric service within Rocky Mountain Power's service area in Idaho.

Eligible Dates

This 2012 application covers equipment purchased on or after January 1, 2012, and on or before December 31, 2012. Incentive applications for 2012 installations must be received no later than January 31, 2013. Applications received after this date may not be processed.

Terms and Conditions

The energy efficient equipment described on this application must be installed in full replacement of existing equipment only. The equipment must be used for irrigation of agricultural crops or pasture, and may not be re-sold or installed for use outside of Rocky Mountain Power service territory in Idaho. The program administrator or Rocky Mountain Power reserves the right to conduct pre-installation on-site inspections to verify the information provided on the applications, and that the customer and equipment are eligible for incentives. After installation, the program administrator and Rocky Mountain Power reserve the right to inspect the system and/or install temporary monitoring equipment at any time, for up to 24 months after the installation, for quality control verification of the application or program performance evaluations.

Customer hereby transfers to Rocky Mountain Power all "Environmental Attributes" attributable to the Energy Efficiency Project or its operation. Environmental Attributes include any and all credits, benefits, emissions reductions, offsets and allowances, howsoever entitled, resulting from the avoidance of the emission of any substance to the air, soil, or water at or by Rocky Mountain Power generating facilities through reduced generation of energy or other savings or offsets on account of the Energy Efficiency Project. Customer will not claim ownership of any Environmental Attributes. As long as Customer at the same time states the Energy Efficiency Project was made possible with funding from Rocky Mountain Power, Customer may claim that it is facilitating the production of the Environmental Attributes attributable to the Energy Efficiency Project.

Qualifying equipment receiving incentives under the Irrigation Energy Savers program may not receive equipment purchase or installation incentives or credits under any other Rocky Mountain Power program, and the Incentive combined with any other grant(s) provided by other entities cannot exceed 100 percent of costs.

Customer must independently evaluate any advice or direction given by the program administrator or Rocky Mountain Power related to estimates of electricity savings or the cost, selection, or installation of equipment.

IN NO EVENT WILL PROGRAM ADMINSTRATOR OR ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER BE LIABLE FOR THE FAILURE OF CUSTOMER TO ACHIEVE A SPECIFIED AMOUNT OF ENERGY SAVINGS, THE OPERATION OF CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES, ANY ECONOMIC OR PHYSICAL HARM TO CUSTOMER OR ANY THIRD PARTY ARISING FROM USE OR INSTALLATION OF THE EQUIPMENT, OR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT OR THE INSTALLATION OF RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT. IN NO EVENT SHALL ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER'S LIABILITY EXCEED ANY OBLIGATION TO PAY THE INCENTIVE FOR WHICH CUSTOMER IS ELIGIBLE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.
