Eligibility Requirements

To participate in the Irrigation Energy Savers program you must be a Rocky Mountain Power Schedule 10 customer who currently uses electricity for irrigation and who receives electric service within Rocky Mountain Power's service area in Idaho.

Existing sprinkler packages with a design flow ≥ 8.5 gpm/acre must be replaced with a new sprinkler package with a design flow ≤ 7.5 gpm/acre. Existing sprinkler packages with a design flow ≥ 7.5 gpm/acre must be replaced with dual sprinkler head assemblies and a second sprinkler package with a design flow ≤ 5.5 gpm/acre. All sprinklers on a center pivot/linear must be replaced. There is a minimum of 80 sprinkler heads and a maximum of 170 sprinkler heads per pivot/linear to qualify for the standard incentive payment.

A custom incentive may be available for systems with fewer than 80 sprinkler heads or more than 170 sprinkler heads or for those systems that do not meet the flow requirements as outlined above. Please contact the program administrator at 1-888-928-3751 to discuss your custom project. When a pivot or linear package is being replaced, drop tubes and new pressure regulators are considered part of the new sprinkler package and are not eligible for individual incentives.

Eligible Dates

This 2012 application covers equipment purchased on or after January 1, 2012, and before December 31, 2012. Incentive applications for 2012 installations must be received no later than January 31, 2013. Applications received after this date may not be processed.

Terms and Conditions

Rocky Mountain Power or the program administrator reserves the right to conduct pre-installation on-site inspections to verify the application meets the qualifiers established in the IPUC approved schedule #155. The incentive application will not be processed until it has passed inspection. After installation Rocky Mountain Power or the program administrator reserves the right to inspect the system any time, for up to 36 months after the installation, for quality control of the application or for program performance evaluations.

The equipment listed on this application must be installed in place of existing equipment only. This program does not apply to new equipment installations. Equipment must be used for irrigation of agricultural crops or pasture and will not be re-sold or installed outside of Rocky Mountain Power territory in Idaho.

Customer hereby transfers to Rocky Mountain Power all "Environmental Attributes" attributable to the Energy Efficiency Project or its operation. Environmental Attributes include any and all credits, benefits, emissions reductions, offsets and allowances, howsoever entitled, resulting from the avoidance of the emission of any substance to the air, soil, or water at or by Rocky Mountain Power generating facilities through reduced generation of energy or other savings or offsets on account of the Energy Efficiency Project. Customer will not claim ownership of any Environmental Attributes. As long as Customer at the same time states the Energy Efficiency Project was made possible with funding from Rocky Mountain Power, Customer may claim that it is facilitating the production of the Environmental Attributes attributable to the Energy Efficiency Project.

Any incentive combined with any other grant, cost share, etc. cannot exceed 100 percent of costs.

Customer shall independently evaluate any advice or direction given by Rocky Mountain Power related to estimates of electricity savings or the cost, selection, or installation of equipment.

Terms and Conditions (cont.)

IN NO EVENT WILL ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER BE LIABLE FOR THE FAILURE OF CUSTOMER TO ACHIEVE A SPECIFIED AMOUNT OF ENERGY SAVINGS, THE OPERATION OF CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES, OR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT OR THE INSTALLATION OF RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER'S LIABILITY EXCEED ANY OBLIGATION TO PAY THE INCENTIVE FOR WHICH CUSTOMER IS ELIGIBLE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

It is the responsibility of the customer to confirm completion by notifying the program administrator and sending the dated copy of PAID sales receipt/invoice to the address listed on the bottom of this application. Equipment must be purchased and installed at a qualifying site within Idaho served by Rocky Mountain Power under Schedule 10 prior to requesting an incentive check. Incentives will not be paid for ineligible or incomplete applications/installations.

Rocky Mountain Power issues Irrigation Energy Savers incentives in the form of checks, not utility bill credits. Rocky Mountain Power is not responsible if your dealer provides inaccurate information about the amount and/or conditions of the actual incentive and Rocky Mountain Power will not pay incentives for equipment that is mislabeled or misrepresented by dealers regarding incentive qualifications. Qualifying equipment receiving incentives under the Irrigation Energy Savers program may not receive incentives or credits under other Rocky Mountain Power programs. Please allow six weeks for your incentive check to arrive.

Customer Acceptance of Terms

Customer agrees to: 1) Purchase and install equipment in a timely manner, 2) provide written notice to program administrator that installation is complete, 3) send copies of paid invoices, and 4) request a final inspection. Failure to provide such notice within 4 months of approval date may cause reserved incentive funds to be re-allocated to other customers.

I herby certify that all information is accurate including claims of customer and equipment information and agree to be bound by them. I have read all terms on this form (front and back) and agree that the program administrator or Rocky Mountain Power may verify all information provided. I authorize Rocky Mountain Power/Program Administrator to request and receive information that is deemed sufficient from any entities for the purpose of determining whether or not the incentive combined with grant exceeds project cost. I certify the project is installed and operational and herby certify that all invoices submitted are original invoices that are authentic and accurately reflect costs incurred in direct connection with the application.

Customer understands that Rocky Mountain Power's only responsibility is to provide a portion of the costs of equipment purchased and installed. Any other warranty or obligation is expressly denied.
