<b>Customer eligibility*</b>	For any size existing facility or new construction	For any size new construction or industrial facility; for commercial retrofits > 20,000 sq. ft. <b>Program technical assistance</b>	Choice of participating vendor or independent consultant for analysis of lighting, HVAC and other upgrades  Our list of vendors is on our website. <b>Program financial offer</b>	Equipment-based incentive (\$/lamp, \$/hp, \$/ton); paid upon completion of project  Our incentive tables are available on our website.	Incentive = \$0.15/kwh annual savings + \$50/kw (up to 70% of project cost); one-year minimum project payback after incentive; paid upon completion of project  In addition, Energy Project Manager co-funding may be available to help customers staff to fully develop and implement projects. Customers commit to achieve an energy savings target of at least 1,000,000 kwh/year in return for the co-funding.	Total bill credit of 80% of eligible measure costs; bill credit is applied monthly against the Customer Efficiency Services charge until total credit is used

<b>New construction/major renovation incentive eligibility requirements</b>	For lighting, whole building interior lighting power must be 10% lower than code**; certain measures are not eligible	Projects must exceed code** or industry common practice	Projects must exceed code** or industry common practice

\*\* This program currently uses the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC 2003) as the baseline for new construction and major renovation.

<b>When to apply</b>	<p><b>Lighting retrofits:</b> sign an incentive agreement before signing purchase orders</p> <p><b>Lighting new construction, chillers:</b> pre-approval is recommended but not required</p> <p><b>Non-lighting:</b> apply after purchase and installation</p> <p><b>Custom incentives</b> (for equipment not listed on incentive tables): sign an incentive agreement before signing purchase orders</p>	Sign a no-obligation letter of intent before you start your project; sign an incentive agreement before signing purchase orders	Submit a project application prior to or after completion of your project; pre-approval is recommended but not required

Rocky Mountain Power also offers Energy Exchange, a load management program, for customers with a peak demand in the previous 12 months of one megawatt or more. Energy Exchange participants receive incentives for curtailing their load during critical times, such as when the demand for electricity on Rocky Mountain Power's system is high or when wholesale electricity market prices are high.
