Dear Program Partner,

On October 17, 2011, Rocky Mountain Power requested approval from the Utah Public Service Commission for modifications to the Rocky Mountain Power ENERGY STAR New Homes Program tariff, Electric Service No. 110. Effective November 16, 2011, a new incentive structure based on ENERGY STAR New Homes Version 2.5 & Version 3 guidelines has been approved. All eligible homes submitted to the program that were placed on hold awaiting tariff approval will now be processed based on this ruling.

If your home was permitted before November 16, 2011 and is an ENERGY STAR Version 2.0, 2.5 or 3 qualified home, incentives will be based on incentive structures in the following tables located in the tariff:

Tariff Sheet No 110.2 - Single Family

Tariff Sheet No 110.3 - Multi-Family

If your home was permitted on or after November 16, 2011 and is an ENERGY STAR Version 2.5 or 3 qualified home, incentives will be based on incentive structures in the following tables located in the tariff:

To help our partners understand how this transition will occur, we have provided an example of some of the changes to incentives depending on the permit date of the home.

Example v2.5 Single Family Home Incentive Changes

Incentives:	Home permitted prior to 11/16	Home permitted on or after to 11/16
Tier 1: Version 2.5	\$250	\$350
Plus Measure: 14 SEER A/C	\$100	\$100
Plus Measure: Duct Placement inside conditioned space	\$100	\$100
Plus Measure: Lighting upgrade to 90% ENERGY STAR qualified CFLs from Tier 1*.	\$75	\$75 Now includes ENERGY STAR qualified CFLs, LEDs, or pin-based lighting in RESNET-defined locations
Plus Measure: Lighting upgrade of an ENERGY STAR Fixture(s)**:	\$20 each	\$0

*Rocky Mountain Power New Homes program guidelines require ENERGY STAR qualified CFLs, LEDs, or pin-based lighting in 80% of fixtures in RESNET-defined Qualifying Light Fixture Locations of a home to be eligible for Rocky Mountain Power incentives. **Standalone ENERGY STAR fixture incentives are being discontinued.
