No age restrictions. Refrigerators and freezers must be in working condition and must be a minimum of 10 cubic feet in size, utilizing inside measurements. Rocky Mountain Power contracts with JACO Environmental, an appliance recycler, to pick up and recycle refrigerators and freezers. Rocky Mountain Power customers must own the unit(s) being recycled. Limit two units per residential address. A check will be mailed within 4-6 weeks after the appliance collection. Some restrictions apply.
