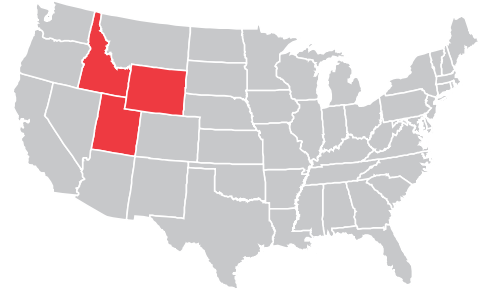

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, is an energy company based in Salt Lake City, Utah. The business efficiently delivers reliable, affordable, safe and environmentally responsible energy to more than 1.1 million customers in Utah, Wyoming and Idaho. The company offers customers electricity from a balanced energy mix using coal, natural gas, hydroelectric, wind, geothermal and solar.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT

- Rocky Mountain Power is a recognized leader in the development and use of renewable energy. Wind, hydro and geothermal resources make up more than 30 percent of the company’s owned generating capacity.
- The company’s \$3.1 billion Energy Vision 2020 plan includes 1,150 megawatts of new wind resources and 999 megawatts of upgraded or “repowered” wind resources to come on-line by the end of 2020.
- Through the company’s Blue SkySM program, participating customers have supported the development of renewable energy for more than a decade and helped fund 148 community-based clean energy projects.

CUSTOMER COMMITMENT

- Customers can access a variety of digital tools to manage energy needs and stay informed during power outages, including by text alert, via email or through the popular Rocky Mountain Power mobile app.
- Through the nationally recognized Subscriber Solar program, more than 2,500 Utahns are getting power from a new 20-megawatt solar plant in Millard County, Utah.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

- To encourage greater electric vehicle adoption and improve air quality, Rocky Mountain Power heads a community effort that is installing 700 EV charging stations in the Intermountain West region by 2020.
- For the past century, Rocky Mountain Power has built relationships with state and local governments and business leaders to strengthen economic development efforts throughout the states it serves.
- The Rocky Mountain Power Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the company, contributed more than \$1.1 million to charitable organizations in the states it serves.

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Rocky Mountain Power is part of a growing western U.S. energy market that maximizes renewable energy, lowers customer costs and improves grid reliability. Since starting in late 2014, the real-time energy market has saved PacifiCorp customers more than \$175 million.
