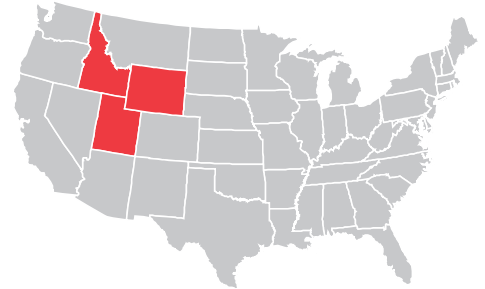

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, is an energy company based in Salt Lake City, Utah. The business efficiently delivers reliable, affordable, safe and environmentally responsible energy to more than 1.1 million customers in Utah, Wyoming and Idaho. The company supplies customers with electricity from a diverse portfolio of generating plants including hydroelectric, natural gas, coal, wind, geothermal and solar resources.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT

- Wind, hydro and geothermal resources make up more than 30 percent of the company’s owned generating capacity.
- To accelerate the company’s affordable and clean energy vision, PacifiCorp is adding 1,150 megawatts of new wind resources and 1,000 MW of upgraded or “repowered” wind resources to come on-line in 2020.
- PacifiCorp’s long-term energy plan calls for adding about 7,000 MW of low-cost wind generation, solar generation and storage resources by 2025.



CUSTOMER COMMITMENT

- Customers can access a variety of digital tools to manage energy needs and stay informed during power outages, including by text alert, via email or through the company’s app.

- Over the last 20 years, Rocky Mountain Power’s award-winning Blue SkySM renewable energy program has brought together more than 140,000 customers to make a difference in communities and the region.
- Rocky Mountain Power partnered with The Wasatch Group and others to develop and manage a first-of-its-kind residential battery demand response solution. This new all-electric apartment building in Utah features 12.6 MW of on-site solar-powered storage to benefit residents and support grid resiliency.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

- To encourage electric vehicle adoption and improve air quality, Rocky Mountain Power has facilitated the installation of 50 DC fast chargers in Utah, and an additional 1,036 chargers at workplaces and in communities.
- The Rocky Mountain Power Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the company, contributed nearly \$1.4 million to charitable organizations in the states it serves.

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Rocky Mountain Power is part of a growing western U.S. energy market that maximizes renewable energy, lowers customer costs and improves grid reliability. Since starting in late 2014, the real-time energy market has saved PacifiCorp customers more than \$235 million.
