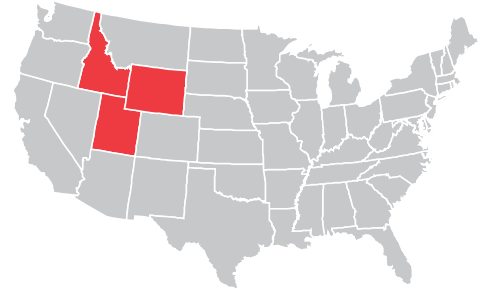

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, is an energy company based in Salt Lake City, Utah. The business efficiently delivers reliable, affordable, safe and environmentally responsible energy to nearly 1.2 million customers in Utah, Wyoming and Idaho. The company supplies customers with electricity from a diverse portfolio of generating plants including hydroelectric, natural gas, coal, wind, geothermal and solar resources.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT

- To accelerate the company’s affordable and clean energy vision, PacifiCorp recently added 1,075 megawatts of wind capacity, bringing its total owned wind capacity to 2,160 megawatts.
- PacifiCorp’s long-term energy plan calls for adding 7,000 megawatts of low-cost wind generation, solar generation and storage resources by 2025.

- Customers can access a variety of digital tools to manage energy needs and stay informed during power outages, including by text alert, via email or through the company’s app.

- By partnering with large customers and growing communities Rocky Mountain Power is creating customized energy solutions that support economic progress and sustainability. For example, three new solar energy projects in Utah will support Facebook’s data center in Eagle Mountain, bringing the total amount of in-state solar energy signed to support Facebook’s regional data centers to 694 megawatts.
- Building upon the success of its innovative battery demand response solution at an all-electric apartment building in Utah, Rocky Mountain Power offers incentives to Utah residents and businesses who integrate qualified storage batteries with the energy grid. The program improves grid resiliency, helping ensure everyone has reliable and affordable power.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

- To encourage electric vehicle adoption and improve air quality, Rocky Mountain Power has facilitated the installation of 60 DC fast chargers in Utah, and an additional 2,045 chargers at workplaces and in communities.
- The Rocky Mountain Power Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the company, contributed more than \$1.4 million in grants in 2020 to charitable organizations and COVID-19 relief efforts in local communities.

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Rocky Mountain Power is part of a growing western U.S. energy market that maximizes renewable energy, lowers customer costs and improves grid reliability. Since starting in late 2014, the real-time energy market has saved PacifiCorp customers more than \$275 million.
- Rocky Mountain Power is installing weather monitoring stations throughout high-risk wildfire areas for deeper insight into weather-related threats, enhanced vegetation management practices, customer communication web tools, and in certain areas like Utah, situational awareness cameras.
