Rocky Mountain Power is making investments to mitigate wildfire risk and help safeguard our communities.

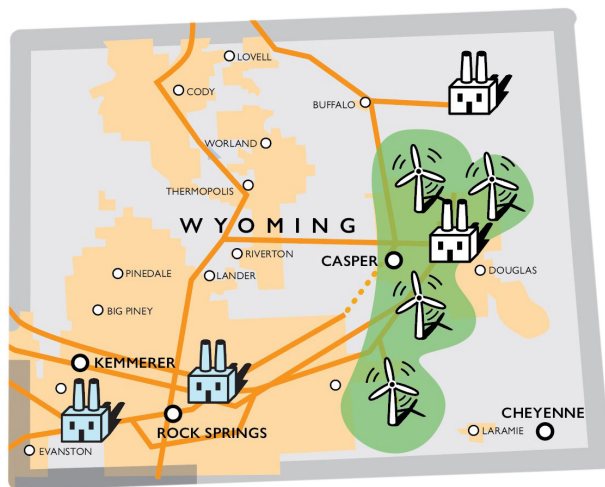
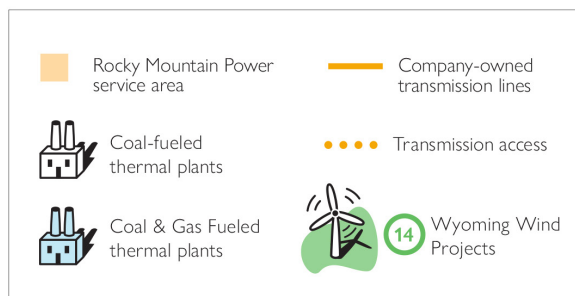
Across our six-state service territory, we've spent \$1 billion on wildfire mitigation and will invest another \$2 billion through 2027. Our advanced weather station network, meteorology team and innovative equipment all help reduce wildfire risk.

Keeping costs low for customers

The company has worked with industry partners to create a transformative energy market across the Western U.S.

Since 2014, the Western Energy Imbalance Market has saved PacifiCorp customers over \$988 million, including \$126 million in allocated benefits for Wyoming customers.
