**RE: ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER NOTIFICATION TO INTERVENING PARTIES
FROM THE 2010 GENERAL RATE CASE STIPULATION**

To Whom It May Concern:

An agreement and Stipulation (“Stipulation”) was reached amongst the intervening parties in the 2010 general rate case (Docket Number 20000-384-ER-10). In the Stipulation, the Company is required to file an application with the Wyoming Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for a Certificate for Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) for the following segments of Energy Gateway project: (1) the Gateway West Transmission Line consisting of the Windstar to Populus Line Segment and the Populus to Hemingway Line Segment; (2) the Aeolus to Mona Line Segment of the Gateway South Transmission Line; and (3) the Hemingway to Captain Jack Line Segment or an equivalent west control area investment in lieu of this line segment.

On June 30 2017, Rocky Mountain Power filed with the Commission an application seeking approval of a CPCN and a proposal for nontraditional ratemaking for cost recovery for projects that include the construction of a 140-mile Aeolus-to-Anticline 500 kilovolt transmission line. This line is a sub-segment of the Windstar to Populus Line Segment, which is subject to the 2010 Stipulation.

This letter requires no action on your part. It is only an informal notification to intervening parties that participated in the 2010 general rate case of the pending application.

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
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
