Three-Phase Residential Service Rider Schedule 18

Available

In all territory served by the Company in the State of Wyoming.

Applicable

To residential Customers requiring three-phase service whose single-phase requirements are or will be supplied under any Residential Schedule contained in this tariff. Three-phase service will be supplied only when service is available from Company's presently existing facilities, or where such facilities can be installed under Company's Line Extension Rules and only when deliveries can be made by using one service for Customer's single-phase and three-phase requirements.

Monthly Billing

The Demand Charge, if applicable, plus the sum of the Basic and Energy Charges of the applicable Residential Service Schedule. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedules 93, 95, 191, 197, and 198.

Basic and Energy Charges

The Customer shall elect for the Basic and Energy Charges to be calculated in accordance with either Residential Service Schedule 2 or Residential Service – Time-of-Use Pilot Schedule 19, as available.

Minimum Charge

Sum of the Schedule 2 Basic and Schedule 18 Demand Charges. Higher minimums may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

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Monthly Billing *(continued)*

Demand

Applicable only to Customer's three-phase Demand. The kW as shown by or computed from the readings of Company's Demand meter for the 15-minute period of Customer's greatest use during the month, rounded to the nearest whole kW.

Continuing Service

Except as specifically provided otherwise, this Schedule is based on continuing service at each service location. Disconnect and reconnect transactions are subject to the provisions set forth in Rule 3, Section VI of this tariff.

Special Conditions

Customer shall arrange wiring to allow the separate metering of the three-phase Demand at a location adjacent to the kWh meter.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by the Wyoming Public Service Commission.

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
