Small General Service Schedule 25

Available

In all territory served by the Company in the State of Wyoming.

Applicable

To non-residential Customers for all electric service required on the Customer's premises whose Demands have not registered more than 20.50 kW or whose energy usages have not registered more than 5,000 kWh in more than six (6) of any continuous twelve (12) month period. Deliveries at more than one point, or more than one voltage and phase classification, will be separately metered and billed. This Schedule is not applicable to standby or breakdown service.

Monthly Billing

The sum of the Basic, Energy, and Reactive Power Charges. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedules 93, 95, 191, 197, and 198.

Monthly Billing *(continued)*

Minimum Charge

The Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

Reactive Power Charge

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kVar in excess of 40% of the measured kW demand for the same month will be billed per kVar of such excess reactive demand.

Demand

The kW as shown by or computed from the readings of the Company's Demand meter for the 15-minute period of the Customer's greatest use during the month, rounded to the nearest whole kW.

Term of Contract

The Company may require the Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of one year.

Communication Devices

Communication devices of municipalities or agencies of municipal, county, state or federal governments with fixed loads that are installed on streetlights, traffic signals or elsewhere and connected to the Company's system for electric service may be unmetered and shall be served under this schedule in accordance with Rule 7.VI. Such unmetered devices, not exceeding 35 line watts per unit, served under multiple Points of Delivery to a single Customer, may be grouped under a single Customer account for billing purposes such that the Customer pays a single Basic Charge for multiple units in addition to the Energy Charge for the cumulative energy for the Customer account. Not more than 100 units shall be grouped under a single account.

Communication Devices *(continued)*

When not otherwise provided for by franchise agreement or other agreement with the Customer, all devices are required to be installed and maintained under a pole attachment agreement. The Customer is required to notify the Company in writing and receive subsequent approval prior to installation, modification or removal of any device.

All devices mounted to Company owned facilities shall be installed, maintained, transferred or removed only by qualified personnel approved in advance by the Company. If approved qualified personnel are not available, the Company may perform these functions at the Customer's expense. Company may also, at their discretion, perform these functions at Customer's expense when part of other Company work on Company-owned facilities.

Continuing Service

Except as specifically provided otherwise, this Schedule is based on continuing service at each service location. Disconnect and reconnect transactions are subject to the provisions set forth in Rule 3, Section VI of this tariff.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by the Wyoming Public Service Commission.

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
