Non-Residential Time-of-Use Pilot Schedule 29

Available

For up to 100 Customers on a first-come, first served basis in all territory served by the Company in the State of Wyoming.

Applicable

To non-residential Customers for all electric service required on the Customer's premises whose loads have not exceeded 999 kW in more than one month of a consecutive twelve (12) month period. Deliveries at more than one point, or more than one voltage and phase classification, will be separately metered and billed. This Schedule is not applicable to standby or breakdown service. Meters enrolled in this pilot will not be eligible to participate concurrently in net metering or any other generation related program offered by the Company.

Monthly Billing

The sum of the Basic, Energy, and Reactive Power Charges. The Monthly Billing also includes the Time-of-Use Metering Fee. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedules 93, 95, 191, 197, and 198.

Monthly Billing *(continued)*

Time-of-Use Periods

On-Peak: 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., and 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., all days.
Off-Peak: All other times.

Minimum Charge

The Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

Reactive Power Charge

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kVar in excess of 40% of the measured kW demand for the same month will be billed per kVar of such excess reactive demand.

Demand

The kW as shown by or computed from the readings of Company's Demand meter for the 15-minute period of Customer's greatest use during the month, rounded to the nearest whole kW.

Term of Contract

Company may require Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of one year.

Program Participation Term

Customers requesting service under this pilot program agree to remain on the pilot for one year. Customers will have the option to opt out of the pilot after this date by notifying the Company. Service will continue under this schedule until Consumer notifies the Company to discontinue service or this schedule terminates.

Continuing Service

Except as specifically provided otherwise, this Schedule is based on continuing service at each service location. Disconnect and reconnect transactions are subject to the provisions set forth in Rule 3, Section VI of this tariff.
