Metered Outdoor Lighting Schedule 54

Available

In all territory served by the Company in the State of Wyoming.

Applicable

To metered outdoor lighting service provided to municipalities, agencies of municipal, county, state or federal governments, schools, or non-profit organizations. Service for purposes other than metered outdoor lighting may not be combined with service under this Schedule for billing purposes. At Customer's option, service for metered outdoor lighting may be taken under Company's applicable General Service Schedule. Service under this Schedule is supplied through one meter at one point of delivery.

Monthly Billing

The sum of the Basic and Energy Charges. All Monthly Billings shall be adjusted in accordance with Schedules 93, 95, 191, 197, and 198.

Minimum Charge

The Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

Special Conditions

1. Customer shall own all poles, wire and other distribution facilities beyond the Company's point of delivery.
2. Company will supply one transformer, or transformer bank, for each service; any additional transformers required shall be supplied and owned by Customer.
3. All transformers owned by Customer must be properly fused and of types and characteristics which conform to Company's standards.
4. When service is supplied to more than one transformer or transformer bank, Company may meter such an installation at primary voltage.

Continuing Service

Except as specifically provided otherwise, this Schedule is based on continuing service at each service location.

Term of Contract

Company may require the Customer to sign a written contract with a minimum term of five years.

Rules

Service under this Schedule is subject to the General Rules contained in the tariff of which this Schedule is a part, and to those prescribed by the Wyoming Public Service Commission.

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
