Changes to Wattsmart Homes Program in Utah

As part of the Company’s efforts for continual improvement, Rocky Mountain Power is planning changes to the Wattsmart Homes program in Utah, effective August 15, 2021. As summarized in the tables below, these changes include adding a stand-alone incentive offering for Ductless Heat Pumps installed in new homes, and discontinuing incentives for LED bulbs and fixtures due to the market transformation and adoption of LED technology. **Any incentive amounts for current Program offerings that are not mentioned in the tables below will remain unchanged.** Existing incentive terms and conditions still apply.
