HOW TO GET YOUR INSTANT INCENTIVES

- Step 1: Identify which lamps to upgrade at your facility, see reverse side for qualifying lamps.
- Step 2: Find a participating instant incentive distributor online at wattsmart.com.
- Step 3: Purchase qualified lamps from a participating distributor¹ and receive your instant incentive. It will appear as a credit on your invoice from the distributor.²
- Step 4: Provide the distributor required business and installation information, and sign the instant incentive customer application when you make your purchase.
- Step 5: Install new lamps in your facility in Idaho served by Rocky Mountain Power and enjoy the savings!

So, now as lamps burn out, it's more affordable than ever to replace them with energy-saving options.

LED lamps on a qualified products list will use 25 to 60 percent less energy than incandescent lighting. And, low-wattage fluorescent lamps can reduce energy use by up to 20 percent. This can add up to big bucks considering about 20 percent of commercial electricity use is attributed to lighting.

LED and low-wattage fluorescent lamps last 35-50 percent longer than incandescent lights. This saves you cost in lamp replacement and reduces the labor expenses and hassle of replacing lights that have burned out.
